**What you need to know before you register:**

***Space is limited; register early. Students are permitted to register for multiple programs.***

**ABC (Arts, Books, and Crafts) Camp:** Monday, July 16<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, July 19<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. in the HS Family and Consumer Science Lab. For students entering K thru 2<sup>nd</sup> grade; limited to 15 students. **DESCRIPTION:** Literacy is used as the foundation for students to complete projects in the areas of art, books, cooking, and crafts.

**Babysitting Certification Class:** Monday, June 11<sup>th</sup> from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. in the MS/HS Media Café. Includes a 30-minute lunch break and (2) 15-minute breaks; students must bring a bagged lunch. **DESCRIPTION:** Offered by the American Red Cross for students age 10 & up; limited to 10 students. Designed for young people to gain the knowledge & skills necessary to safely & responsibly give care to infants & children in a residential setting. Learn about basic child care & basic first aid.

**Basketball Basics (elementary):** Monday, July 9<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, July 12<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m. in the MS Gym. For students entering grades 4 and 5; limited to 20 students; co-ed. **DESCRIPTION:** Students will be working on practicing the basic fundamentals of stretching, dribbling, passing, shooting, layups, general offense/defense and learning the different areas on the court. **Note Dress Code:** students must wear sneakers; shorts and t-shirt recommended.

For students entering 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade; limited to 25 students. **DESCRIPTION:** HWEF is partnering with the Capital Area Intermediate Unit to offer a week-long experience in coding, game development, robotics, engineering, photography, and design. Students must bring a packed lunch.
